AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 7386 DEALING GENERALLY WITH AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER TECHNOLOGY.

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2013 the Council of the City of Lee's Summit approved Ordinance No. 7386 that recognized the use of automated license plate readers and further established certain restrictions related to the use of these readers; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the accreditation process, the Lee's Summit Police Department has established policies for the use of license plate readers and management of resulting data that are consistent with national standard best practices; and,

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to repeal the existing ordinance and allow the Police Department to rely on the accredited policies that have been established.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 7386 passed by the Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri on October 10, 2013 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
