AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT RENEWAL FOR AUTOMOTIVE SALES IN DISTRICT CP-2 ON LAND LOCATED AT 1001 SE OLDHAM PARKWAY FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY (20) YEARS, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 10 WITHIN THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, on July, 17, 2003, by Ordinance No. 5561, the City Council granted a special use permit for automotive sales for a period of twenty (20) years on land located at 1001 SE Oldham Parkway; and,

WHEREAS, Application #PL2018-078, submitted by Farchmin Dicus, P.C., requesting approval of a special use permit for automotive sales in District CP-2 on land located at 1001 SE Oldham Parkway, was referred to the Planning Commission to hold a public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, the Unified Development Ordinance provides for the approval of a special use permit by the City following public hearings by the Planning Commission and City Council; and,

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the Planning Commission held a public hearing for the request on June 26, 2018, and rendered a report to the City Council containing findings of fact and a recommendation that the special use permit be approved; and,

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the City Council held a public hearing on July 26, 2018, and rendered a decision to grant said special use permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the application pursuant to Section 10.450 and Section 10.020.A of the Unified Development Ordinance to allow automotive sales in District CP-2 with a Special Use Permit is hereby granted for a period of twenty (20) years, with respect to the following described property:

Lot 1, Van Duss Business Park, a subdivision of record in Lee's Summit, Jackson County, Missouri

SECTION 2. That the following conditions of approval apply:

1. The special use permit shall be granted for a period of twenty (20) years.

SECTION 3. That failure to comply with all of the provisions contained in this ordinance shall constitute violations of both this ordinance and the City Unified Development Ordinance, No. 5209.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
