AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI ACCEPTING THE GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$450,000 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN, FOR A COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT AND HOPE HOUSE, INC. ON COMMUNITY-DEFINED SOLUTIONS TO VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN.

WHEREAS, the City and Hope House, Inc. have previously worked together to develop a coordinated community response to domestic violence; and,

WHEREAS, Hope House, Inc. drafted a grant application on behalf of the City to obtain funding to continue this community response; and,

WHEREAS, City Council previously approved the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding between the City and Hope House, Inc. as part of the grant application; and,

WHEREAS, the City was awarded the grant in the amount of \$450,000 and must receive City Council approval to accept and execute the grant award.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The grant award in the amount of \$450,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women, to the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri for a collaboration between the City and Hope House, Inc. on community-defined solutions to violence against women is hereby accepted, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents related to such grant award.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
