This past weekend was the deadline for the Governor to veto or sign legislation passed in this year's session. The list below only identifies the six bills the Governor vetoed; the other 85 Truly Agreed and Finally Passed bills were signed by the Governor; he even approved all of the appropriations bills without any line-item veto.


None of these bills affects the City other than HB 147 which would have improved the court's ability to collect fines by authorizing the suspension of a person's license for nonpayment. Unfortunately, that was the specific provision on which his veto was based.

While the legislature will have the ability to override the Governor's veto when they meet September 11, we do not anticipate any effort on any of these bills to even attempt an override. However, we will send a report following veto session.
