## Payment Options



- Water Utilities offers multiple payment options
  - Mail to bank (Lockbox)
  - Customer's online banking (eLockbox)
  - Bank Draft (ACH)
  - UtilityLink web portal (WEB) via credit card
  - Telephone (IVR Interactive Voice Response) via cc
  - Counter/Dropboxes at City Hall and Water Utilities

#### **Credit Card Fees**



- In FY19, combined cost for WEB & IVR transactions exceeded \$368,000
  - Included payment gateway and processing fees
- Staff issued an RFP and selected a new vendor for payment processing to enhance services.
  - IVR system was hosted locally that had aged and needed to be phased out.
  - Challenges with coordination with gateway provider and processor.
  - Limitations in telephone line availability of hosted IVR.
  - Security / PCI Compliance requirements.

#### **Credit Card Fees**



- In March of 2019, the RFP was awarded to Paymentus.
- Expected to "go live" by the end of January 2020.
- Features of new web portal and telephone payment system:
  - Additional bank card options
  - eCheck option
  - Schedule payments & recurring payments
  - Continued ebill option
  - Lower costs to Utility (est \$131,000 based on FY19)

#### Convenience Fees



Customer Satisfaction Survey

As a customer, would you prefer the fee associated with paying your utility bill electronically be shared by all or charged individually?

Customers responded

**59% Individual Charged** 

**30% Shared Cost** 

11% No response

#### Convenience Fees



- City while switching banking services contract determined that a 2.5% convenience fee was necessary to offset processing costs.
  - Implemented as of December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Multiple other utilities, schools, counties charge convenience fees due to the processing costs.

#### Question:

– Should processing charges continue to be absorbed or should a convenience fee be applied to capture the costs of this payment option?

> Current configuration of Paymentus system assumes an absorption of all processing charges but can be changed prior to "go live"
