AN ORDINANCE AWARDING BID NO. 34331683-C, FOR THE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT – FY20 TO WIEDENMANN, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,396,331.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, approximately 15,000 feet of existing water mains are planned to be replaced, pursuant to this project; and,

WHEREAS, the water mains included in this project have exhibited increased break rates in recent years and are now due for replacement; and,

WHEREAS, water main will be replaced using a combination of trench and trenchless installation methods, with most water mains being installed by pipe bursting; and,

WHEREAS, Public Works Engineering issued Bid No. 34331683-C on January 21, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, Wiedenmann, Inc., was determined to be the lowest and most responsible bidder by City Staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby authorizes the award of bid no. 34331683-C to Wiedenmann, Inc., in the amount of \$2,396,331.00.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit hereby authorizes the execution, by the City Manager, of an agreement with Wiedenmann, Inc. for the services contained in bid no. 34331683-C in an amount of \$2,396,331.00. Said contract is on file with the City of Lee's Summit Public Works Department and is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
