AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE AWARD OF BID FOR PROJECT NO. 728 FOR THE 2020 PAVEMENT MARKING SERVICES WITH POSSIBLE THREE (3) CONSECUTIVE ONE YEAR CONTRACT RENEWALS TO STREETWISE, INC. BASED ON UNIT PRICES REFLECTED IN THE ATTACHED BID TABULATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME BY AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, visible pavement stripes and symbols are essential for traffic safety; and,

WHEREAS, painted stripes lose their visibility after one to two years and thermoplastic symbols lose their visibility after four years due to wear and tear from traffic, snow removal, salt products, and weather; and,

WHEREAS, the Pavement Marking Services Contract provides for the restoration of existing pavement marking and symbols and some new markings and symbols of 168 centerline miles of City streets; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works department issued the bid for Project No. 728 Pavement Marking Services on January 29, 2020 on the City's website and at Quest Construction Data Network; and,

WHEREAS, two bids were received by the February 19, 2020 bid opening date; and,

WHEREAS, the bid of Streetwise, Inc. was determined to be the lowest and most responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby authorizes the award of bid for Project No. 728 to Streetwise, Inc. based on the unit prices reflected in the attached bid tabulation.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby authorizes the execution, by the City Manager, of an agreement with Streetwise, Inc. for the services contained in the bid for Project No. 728 based on the unit prices reflected in the attached bid tabulation. Said contract is on file with the City of Lee's Summit Public Works Department and is incorporated by reference as if full set forth herein.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
