## **AMENDED BILL NO. 20-41**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT PLAN LOCATED AT 1275 SE OLDHAM PKWY IN DISTRICT CP-2, PROPOSED CULVER'S, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 33, THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE OF LEE'S SUMMIT CODE OF ORDINANCES, FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Application #PL2019-413, submitted by Engineering Solutions, LLC, requesting approval of a preliminary development plan in District CP-2 (Planned Community Commercial District) on land located at 1275 SE Oldham Pkwy was referred to the Planning Commission to hold a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Development Ordinance provides for the approval of a preliminary development plan by the City following public hearings by the Planning Commission and City Council, and

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the Planning Commission held a public hearing for the consideration of the preliminary development plan on February 13, 2020, and rendered a report to the City Council recommending that the preliminary development plan be approved; and

WHEREAS, after due public notice in the manner prescribed by law, the City Council held a public hearing on March 3, 2020 and approved a motion for a second ordinance reading to approve the preliminary development plan for said property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That a preliminary development plan is hereby approved in District CP-2 on the following described property:

First Federal Bank Commercial Park, Lot 2

SECTION 2. That the following conditions of approval apply:

- 1. A modification shall be granted to the high-impact landscape buffer/screen requirement, to allow a 8' tall opaque wood fence with masonry columns to be constructed on the south property line.
- 2. Preliminary development plan approval shall only be for Lot 3 (Culver's site) and Tract A. Development of Lot 4 shall require preliminary development plan approval under separate application.
- 3. The Developer shall execute a mutually satisfactory development agreement with the City, which addresses, at a minimum, the traffic-related improvements included in the Transportation Impact Analysis (TIA). No building permits shall be issued for any structure in the development until written proof is provided to the City that the development agreement has been recorded in the Jackson County Recorders' Office. All public improvements shall be substantially complete prior to any occupancy.
- 4. To comply with the requirements of the UDO, a 5' sidewalk shall be constructed along the development's SE Oldham Pkwy frontage.

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SECTION 3. That development shall be in accordance with the preliminary development plan, date stamped December 11, 2019, January 13, 2020, and January 17, 2020, as described in the staff report.

SECTION 4. Nonseverability. All provisions of this ordinance are so essentially and inseparably connected with, and so dependent upon, each other that no such provision would be enacted without all others. If a court of competent jurisdiction enters a final judgment on the merits that is not subject to appeal and that declares any provision or part of this ordinance void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then this ordinance, in its collective entirety, is invalid and shall have no legal effect as of the date of such judgment.

SECTION 5. That failure to comply with all of the provisions contained in this ordinance shall constitute violations of both this ordinance and Chapter 33, the City's Unified Development Ordinance, of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Lee's Summit.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
