License Tax Background

Ocity Ordinance 4592

- Sections 28-175 through 28-123 in Code of Ordinances
- Adopted March 17, 1998
- Fees Amended 2007, 2015, 2016 and 2018
- O Administrative cleanup 2019
- O Tax paid by development activity
 - Ø Building permit, and/or
 - O Creates additional traffic / vehicle trips

O Tax used for "streets and related improvements"


License Tax Background

 - Ø Finance: Report revenues
 - Planning: Report building permit activities

 - Recommendations regarding rates

 License Tax Committee "shall review Staff's Annual Report and forward comments to the Council"


Residential Building Permits

Retail, Office and Industrial Permit Projection




License Tax Annual Revenue Estimates

Net Excise Tax with Commercial\$100 (13.33%) Increase

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
License Tax Fund Balance Projections

Comparison of Total License Tax Fund Balance Scenarios Tax Balance

Fund Balance with 10% Residential Fee Increase in FY2020: \$10,624,000 Fund Balance with 5% Across the Board Increase in FY2020: \$10,428,500

Fund Balance with \$100 (13.33%) Commercial Fee Increase in FY2020: \$10,262,000

Fund Balance with no changes in existing fees: \$10,096,500

Current Tax Rates

Land Use Category	License Tax Rate
Residential	\$1,088 per residential unit
Manufacturing / Industrial	\$1,000 per new trip
Commercial	\$ 750* per new trip


Notes regarding Rates:

Maximum rate \$2,116 approved by voters in 1997
Relatively low compared to KC Metro area

*Committee recommended to increase commercial to \$850 per trip (13.33% increase) starting in FY21

License Tax Review Committee Recommendations

- 1. Increase commercial rates from \$750 per trip to \$850 per trip
- Program \$6.0 million of license tax funds into CIP for US 50 / M219 North interchange improvements

Request for Guidance

- What action does Council want to take regarding Committee's recommendation to increase commercial rates from \$750 per trip to \$850 per trip?
 - Requires ordinance amendment to increase fees
 - Asking Council to
 - o direct staff to prepare ordinance if want to increase fee
 - O direct staff to take no action and report Council direction back to Committee
- O Does Council support programming \$6.0 million of license tax funds into CIP for US 50 / M219 North interchange improvements?
 - Ø Would be completed as part of annual CIP process
 - Asking if Council wants to direct staff to program the funding into the CIP for the recommended project
