AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, AND TRANSYSTEMS CORPORATION FOR THE PRYOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS FROM LONGVIEW ROAD TO HOOK ROAD (RFQ NO. 2020-046) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,114,598.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT OF THE SAME.

WHEREAS, as approved as part of the FY 2017 Capital Improvement Plan, the City sought qualified firms to provide professional engineering services for the Pryor Road Improvements from Longview Road to Hook Road (hereinafter "Project") with the issuance of RFQ No. 2020-046; and,

WHEREAS, at the close of the time period for submissions, the City received a total of seven (7) responses which were reviewed by City staff; and

WHEREAS, after conducting interviews with three firms, Transystems Corporation (hereinafter "Engineer") was determined to be the most qualified to undertake such an assignment; and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager is authorized and empowered by the City to execute contracts providing for professional engineering services; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Engineer to perform the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby approves an Agreement for Professional Engineering Services between the City and Engineer for the Project (RFQ No. 2020-046) for an amount not to exceed \$1,114,598.00 attached hereto as "Exhibit 1", and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the same.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
