## BILL NO. 20-71

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR PROJECT NO. 548 FOR THE STREAMBANK STABILIZATION PROJECTS: SE 2<sup>ND</sup> STREET; SW 3<sup>RD</sup> STREET; AND CEDAR CREEK TO TASCO, LLC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$672,387.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT OF THE SAME.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 8346 and Ordinance No. 8580, Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc., designed the stabilization of three separate streambank areas near SE 2<sup>nd</sup> Street near Independence Avenue; SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Street near Winterpark Drive, and SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Cedar Creek ("Project No. 548"); and

WHEREAS, the Project will protect existing public infrastructure and mitigate the potential risk of closing public roadways due to on-going bank erosion; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 19-14, City staff applied for a grant from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources to assist with the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources approved \$192,910.50 in matching grant funds toward the Project; and

WHEREAS, Public Works Engineering issued a bid no. 54832272-2C for the project on February 24, 2020, and,

WHEREAS, six (6) responsive bids were received and reviewed at the bid opening on March 26, 2020;

WHEREAS, Tasco, LLC ("Contractor"), was determined to be the lowest bidder by City staff and meets all of the City's qualifications; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Contractor to construct the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby awards the bid for Project No. 548 to the Contractor in the amount of \$672,387.00.

SECTION 2. That the agreement attached hereto as "Exhibit A" by and between the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, and the Contractor is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
