AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT AND THE JACKSON COUNTY PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 13, THE PROVISION OF AND THE TERMINATION OF WATER SERVICE AND SEWER SERVICE AND EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Lee's Summit is a constitutional charter City, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri (hereinafter "City"); and,

WHEREAS, the District is a public water supply district organized and existing pursuant to Chapter 247 RSMo: and,

WHEREAS, the District provides water service to customers within geographic boundaries of the District not otherwise conveyed to the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City provides sewer service to customers within the geographic boundaries of the District; and,

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 16, of the Missouri Constitution and Section 70.220, RSMo, authorize cooperative Agreements between municipalities and other political subdivisions.

WHEREAS, Section 393.016, RSMo, authorizes water districts to contract with cities for the termination of water service when fees from City provided sewer services are in arrears.

WHEREAS, both the City and the District are desirous of reaching an Agreement and understanding regarding the provision of water and sewer service in that portion of their respective territories which overlap.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement for the provision of water and sewer services to the City of Lee's Summit property owners receiving water services through Jackson County Public Water Supply District No. 13 for the exchange of water meter readings, customer information and the termination of water services for delinquent City sewer accounts and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the same by and on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences or clauses.
