AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR PROJECT NO. 419 FOR THE JEFFERSON STREET IMPROVEMENTS: PERSELS ROAD TO OLDHAM PARKWAY TO MEGAKC CORPORATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,589,276.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, as the project was recommended in the City's 2006 and 2015 Thoroughfare Master Plans and pursuant to Ordinance No. 8109, and George Butler Associates, Inc. designed for the widening and reconstruction of Jefferson Street between Persels Road to Oldham Parkway (hereinafter "Project No. 419"); and,

WHEREAS, funding for Project No. 419 was authorized in the City's Capital Improvement Plan from FY17 through FY21; and,

WHEREAS, Public Works Engineering issued a bid for Project No. 419 on April 20, 2020 in accordance with local policies and state statutes; and,

WHEREAS, MegaKC Corporation (hereinafter "Contractor") was determined to be the lowest and best bidder by City staff; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Contractor to construct Project No. 419 for the Jefferson Street Improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, hereby awards the bid for Project No. 419 to the Contractor in the amount of \$2,589,276.00.

SECTION 2. That the agreement attached hereto as "Exhibit A" by and between the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, and the Contractor is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
