AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE CONTRACT BETWEEN EAGLE COUNTY PARAMEDIC SERVICES, PUBLIC SAFETY ASSOCIATION, INC., AND PHYSIO-CONTROL, INC., TO PURCHASE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES AS NEEDED AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO USE THE SAME FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, the Governor of the State of Missouri, and the Mayor of the City of Lee's Summit (the "City"), have each declared a state of emergency in response to the 2019 novel coronavirus ("COVID-19"); and,

WHEREAS, the City has a need to purchase medical equipment and accessories to respond to and mitigate against the spread of COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, Section 6.1 of the Procurement Policy allows the City to make purchases from contracts that were originally procured by another entity but have extended the pricing and terms of such contract to other entities such as the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City is able to purchase medical equipment and accessories pursuant to a contract between Public Safety Association Inc., a third party aggregator that brings entities together, and Physio-Control, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Procurement Policy requires a cooperative contract with an estimated annual spend of \$50,000.00 or more to be approved by City Council before it is used; and,

WHEREAS, the City anticipates spending over \$50,000.00 annually on the purchase of the medical equipment and accessories.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri hereby approves the City's use of the contract between Eagle County Paramedic Services, Public Safety Association Inc., and Physio-Control, Inc. (referred to as "Cooperative Agreement"), attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, and authorizes the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to use the Cooperative Agreement to purchase medical equipment and accessories.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Should any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, or clauses.
