Roles and Responsibilities

• Staff:

- Hold pre-application meetings
- Review applications for completeness
- Provide fair, ethical and professional advice and recommendations
- Provide background information and staff reports
- Prepare UDO text amendments for consideration
- Answer technical questions

Roles and Responsibilities

• Planning Commission:

- Primarily Advisory Role to City Council
- Sole Responsibility for Comprehensive Plan
- Holds public hearings on development related applications and makes recommendations to City Council
- Approves Preliminary Plats and Reviews Final Plats
- Provides input into UDO Amendments

Roles and Responsibilities

- City Council:
 - Sets Policy
 - Mayor Appoints Planning Commission
 - Decides Legislative Actions (Rezonings, PDP's, Zoning Ordinance Amendments)
 - Approves Final Plats

[Political Perspective]



Motions

- Written motions are provided by staff
 - The default position is to match staff's recommendation
 - The Commission must forward a recommendation of approval, denial or continue the application
 - Adding, deleting or modifying specific conditions should be discussed and conveyed through the maker of the motion
 - After a motion is seconded the discuss should focus on the substance of the motion itself

- Amending motions
 - Vote on the amendment language
 - Then come back to the parent motion
