- B. [2021-3974](#)** Discussion of pending State Legislative Items

Mayor Baird arrived to the meeting.

City Attorney Brian Head went over the list provided by our Lobbyist (Jim Durham) of priority items.

There was brief discussion regarding:

1. [HB 920](#): This bill references moving the general municipal election date to November for Mayor and Council elections. This would possibly require Charter amendments if passed.

2. Wayfair/Cable gross receipt tax: If the bill passes it will change the way items are calculated. The bill reduces the items that are included in the calculation of gross receipts and would result in a reduction in tax revenue. Staff indicates that there is likely to be additional reconciliation between the Cable bill and the Wayfair bill prior to passage but that it does appear that the legislature intends to reduce, limit or cap the fees.
