

RESEARCH METHOD

Summary of assumptions

- Reviewed annual budgets and audits of independent health departments in MO
 - Segregated costs that are grant funded vs locally-funded through taxes and fees
 - Example of grant-funded service is Women, Infant, Children (WIC) services.
 - Calculated per capita costs for comparison
- Assumed construction of \$4.6 million facility
 - 25,000 sf building
 - Estimated project cost calculated using RSMeans
 - Debt service calculated using current GO market rates for Aaa-rated cities over 20-years
- Other capital costs rolled into program budgets
- COLS already provides animal control services through police department
- Demographics and service level demands considered
