I. Call to Order. Jane called the meeting to order at 6:40pm.

- **III. Approval of February25 Meeting Minutes.** Motion to approve made by Jeanine Akins. Motion seconded by Nick Parker. Motion carried.
- IV. Resignation of Mellissa Garris. Motion to remove Mellissa Garris from LSAC due to lack of attendance was made by Nick Parker. Jeanning Akins seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- V. Got Talent Sponsorship Proposal. The council discussed history of LSAC grants to the event, which is sponsored by LS Cares. Event is well-attended and held at LS High School. Bob Jones made a motion to approve a \$500 level sponsorship for Got Talent. John Schuler seconded the motion. Discussion: If we would like our logo to get into the public on flyers, we need to sponsor at the \$1000 level. A link to our website would be included in materials for event. Nick Parker made a proposed to amend the motion to support a sponsorship at the \$1,000 level. Jeannine Akins seconded the motion as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

VI. Committee Reports

a. Budget Committee. Glenda gave the report for Gary.

Projections for FY19 were updated and the Cultural Arts budget is projected to end close to what was budgeted. A budget proposal for FY20 is still being developed. The biggest change is an increase in advertising expenses to adequately promote what is going on with LSAC sponsored events and events around LS. Glenda explained changes in Professional Fees Expense line item and Advertising Expense line item.
