

**Lee's Summit Arts Council  
June 24, 2019 Meeting Minutes**

- I. **Call to Order.** Jane called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm.

- III. **Approval of Minutes.** Gary Fruits made the motion to approve the minutes from the May 29 meeting. Motion seconded by Nick Parker and passed unanimously.
- IV. **Introduction of New Arts Council Members.** Glenda introduced the newest members to the Arts Council, Brenda Harris and Jen Steller. Mayor Pro Tem Lopez was appointed as the new City Council liaison and will begin attending at the July meeting.

Unfortunately, after review and discussion of the prototype by Creative Services and Legal team it was determined that having the ArtsKCGO calendar integration would not be feasible. The reason being that the City would not have access to manage the calendar entries and promoting non-city activities on the City’s web-page conflicts with its promotional policies.
