

MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing was held by The Industrial Development Authority of the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri (the "Authority") on Wednesday, March 10, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. via toll-free teleconference. Participants were encouraged to join the hearing telephonically to promote compliance with local orders and in compliance with IRS Revenue Procedure 2020-21 and 2020-49. The hearing was conducted on behalf of the Authority by Chris Williams, counsel to the Authority.

Mr. Williams announced the commencement of the public hearing regarding the proposed issuance by the Authority of its revenue bonds in one or more series in the aggregate maximum principal amount of not to exceed \$36,000,000 for the purpose of providing funds to John Knox Village, a Missouri nonprofit corporation (the "Corporation"), to make a loan to finance the costs of the construction of 52 new independent living units, to be located at the Corporation's campus at 400 NW Murray Road in the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

The public hearing was open to the public and everyone was given the opportunity to express their views, both orally and in writing, for or against the proposed issuance of the bonds or to ask any questions with respect thereto.

No members of the public attended the hearing telephonically. At 10:05 a.m. Mr. Williams declared the public hearing adjourned with no objections or other comments filed.
