A. 2021-4313 Approval of the August 11, 2021 Community and Economic Development Action Letter.

Councilmember Felker made a motion to approve the August 11, 2021 Community and Economic Development Action Letter, seconded by Vice Chair DeMoro.

B. 2021-4341 Proposed Amendment to short-term rental regulations, UDO Section 6.505

Hector Soto, Jr., Planning Manager, reviewed the City's current UDO Section 6.505.B relating to short-term rentals and explained a short-term rental is a rental less than seven consecutive days.

Michelle and Michael Belman, were present to represent the applicant, Mindy Templeton, who is asking for an amendment to condition B that states the owner or a local representative must occupy a dwelling unit on the same parcel or an adjacent parcel. The Belman's own several property management companies in the Kansas City area and explained some of the guidelines they use to manage local Airbnb's and answered questions from the committee.

After discussion, staff was asked to gather additional information on this topic and research other city ordinances pertaining to short-term rentals then bring this item back to the committee for further review.
