1. Call to order

Chairperson Beasley called the meeting to order at 6:36 p.m.

Commissioner Schuler stated the Chamber is supportive of the idea. She suggested keeping it tied to the Chamber and Lee's Summit Cares for the Mayor's Character Breakfast to take advantage of their advertising.

6. Todd George Information – Commissioner Karen Schuler

Commissioner Schuler reported she has spoken with Mr. Steve Arbo, City Manager, regarding the renaming of Todd George Parkway. Mr. Arbo stated Mayor Baird has tasked the Diversity and



Inclusion Commission to come up with a process for those conversations. A meeting has been set with Mayor Baird in the next week or two.

7. Roundtable

Commissioner Beasley also resigned from the Commission. He has been appointed by Mayor Baird to serve on the Commission for Diversity and Inclusion.
