B. 2021-4366 Continued Discussion of Legislative Priorities

The Committee made some suggestions to the Legislative Priorities handout as follows:

1. First paragraph first sentence only -suggested change:

"Lee's Summit is a growing community in the Kansas City area and the 6th largest City in the State.

2. Under Revenue - Third bullet suggested change:

"Support Tax Legislation that protects Municipal Revenue"

The Consensus of the Committee agreed to make the suggested changes as discussed and have staff send a Resolution to the full Council for the December 21, 2021 Council meeting.

Brian Head mentioned he will forward the updates he receives from our Lobbyist to the full council around December 1 so they will be able to watch as bills are pre-filed.
