B. [2022-4647](#) Review Current Bills of Municipal Interest

City Attorney Brian Head informed the Committee that he did not receive an official Legislative update from our lobbyist. He did a brief update on a few things that he was aware of:

1. Senate Debate - congressional redistricting.
2. Amtrak Funding
3. HB1614 - Prohibits the state and any political subdivision from regulating certain uses of private property.
4. SB 743 - This bill would modify provisions related to taxation.

There was brief discussion on the bills.

There was conversation regarding making a trip to the Capitol as a group at some point. Mr. Head mentioned the annual train ride that the Chamber hosts.
