B. 2022-5237 Presentation: Infill Policy Discussion

Josh Johnson, Director of Development Services, presented information on infill and provided several examples for the committee. After discussion and questions, staff was asked to bring back additional information for further review and discussion.

9C. SUBSTITUT E BILL NO. 23-163 An Ordinance amending Chapter 33, Unified Development Ordinance of the Lee's Summit Code of Ordinances, Article 7 Subdivisions, to allow for requirement of public infrastructure with the administrative approval of minor plats.

(Note: First read by Council on August 22, 2023. Passed by unanimous vote.)

Josh Johnson, Director of Development Services, explained the purpose of this ordinance is to improve the minor plat process when dividing lots. Currently administrative approval of minor plats does not allow for requirement of public infrastructure and the proposed ordinance changes clarify that Council is directing staff to require public infrastructure through minor plats that create new lots.

A motion was made by Councilmember Shields, seconded by Councilmember Prier to recommend to the Planning Commission, approval of an Ordinance amending Chapter 33, Unified Development Ordinance, of the Lee's Summit Code of Ordinances, Article 7, Subdivision1, to allow for requirement of public infrastructure with the administrative approval of minor plats.

D. TMP-2621 An Ordinance amending Chapter 33, Unified Development Ordinance, of the Lee's Summit Code of Ordinances, Article 6, Division IV, Subdivision 1, by updating the general requirements for accessory uses and structures and Article 6, Division II, Subdivision 2, by updating the short term rental

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regulations.

Shannon McGuire, Planner, reviewed the results of the ADU public outreach survey. He then presented proposed amendments to the current policy as well as examples of types of ADU's. After discussion, staff was asked to bring back proposed amendments that include additional information on zones, specific lot sizes for ADU's and short term rentals.
