An Ordinance approving the use of a Cooperative Contract between Eagle County Paramedic Services, Public Safety Association Inc., and Physio-Control, Inc. to purchase medical equipment and accessories as needed and authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to use the same for the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri. Issue/Request:

An Ordinance approving the use of a Cooperative Contract between Eagle County Paramedic Services, Public Safety Association Inc., and Physio-Control, Inc. to purchase medical equipment and accessories as needed and authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to use the same for the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

Key Issues:

- Officials at the federal, state, and local level each declared a state of emergency in response to the 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19)
- The initial purchase using this contract will be for the purchase of equipment to respond to and mitigate against the spread of COVID-19
- The Fire Department has the need to purchase replacement and new medical equipment from time to time
- The initial purchase of equipment will be using CARES Act funding, totaling more than \$50,000.00.
- Estimated expenditure to be paid for with CARES Act funding, \$91,663, for five (5) LUCAS -Chest Compression Systems. The purchase is not a part of the City's current budget.

Proposed City Council Motion:

FIRST MOTION: I move for a second reading of an Ordinance approving the use of a Cooperative Contract between Eagle County Paramedic Services, Public Safety Association Inc. and Physio-Control, Inc. to purchase medical equipment and accessories as needed and authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to use the same for the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

SECOND MOTION: I move for adoption of an Ordinance approving the use of a Cooperative Contract between Eagle County Paramedic Services, Public Safety Association Inc. and Physio-Control, Inc. to purchase medical equipment and accessories as needed and authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents necessary to use the same for the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

Background:

This is a new cooperative/piggy back contract to purchase medical equipment manufactured by Physio-Controls. The City in the past has used other cooperative agreements to purchase Physio-Control equipment. The new contract will provide a source for the Fire department through November 2023.

Impact/Analysis:

Initial purchase in response to and mitigating against the spread of COVID-19, will be made using CARES Act funds, future purchases may be included in the annual budgeting process.
