

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI AND THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI TO ALLOW THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT TO JOIN THE METROPOLITAN REGIONAL RADIO SYSTEM.

Proposed Committee Motion:

I move to recommend to City Council the adoption of AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI AND THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI TO ALLOW THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT TO JOIN THE METROPOLITAN REGIONAL RADIO SYSTEM.

Background:

Currently, the City of Lee's Summit operates on a Motorola conventional UHF simulcast system with two tower sites. The current system was upgraded in 2011 by the City but doesn't have direct interoperability with MARRS. The City of Lee's Summit placed a bond issue on the November 2016 ballot for improving the public safety radio system, which was passed by voters. This agreement is a continuation of that process to improve the Lee's Summit radio system and join MARRS. (F&BC 11-6-17)
