Issue/Request:

Key Issues:

- Departments reviewed their expenditures for the first half of the fiscal year and updated their anticipated budgetary needs for the remained or the fiscal year
- Based on the updates the Municipal Courts department needs additional spending authority to complete the FY24 budget year
- The additional authority is a result of additional need to use the contracted Public Defender for cases
