### Points of Order and Debate Discussion

During the March 7, 2019 Roundtable, Councilmember Johnson brought up the debate process and the rights of the members to be recognized during debate. He stated that the current rules do not require recognition of a speaker. Also of some concern was the proper procedure if in the future someone would attempt to interrupt the speaker who had the floor. The Council has adopted Robert's Rules of Order except where specifically changed by the Council's adoption of a rule. The Committee requested Staff bring back information on Robert's Rules regarding Points of Order and rights of debate of members of a body.
