Issue/Request:

This ordinance is a companion to item TMP-1660. This ordinance amends the FY21 Budget to add a new fund (Fund 255 "CARES Act Fund" and authorizes expenditures of \$5,921,527 and accounts for same related revenue. Creating this separate fund will provide for greater transparency, tracking, and reporting of expenditures from the CARES Act funds dispersed under the intergovernmental agreement with Jackson County.
