An Ordinance amending Chapter 33, the Unified Development Ordinance, of the Lee's Summit Code of Ordinances, Articles 6 and 15, to amend home occupation restrictions to comply with recent changes to state statutes.

### Issue/Request:

The State of Missouri recently passed a law overriding cities' ability to regulate home occupations. The attached amendments are a reflection of the new statute. There are a package of four exhibits altering the UDO. The home occupation standards are scattered across multiple sections of the UDO. Staff will prepare a presentation for the CEDC to address the implications of these changes.

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
