## **Key Issues:**

- -The Procurement Policy is to be reviewed and updated at least every three years
- -City Staff, including Procurement and Contract Services, Law, department users, managers, and directors were provided the opportunity to provide input and suggestions for improvements to the policy
- -The most significant change to the policy is increasing the City Managers signature authority from \$50,000 to \$75,000.
