FY24 Capital Improvement Plan Review

Key Issues:

## Background:

City staff presented a kickoff discussion for the FY24 Capital Improvement Plan at the November 2022 Public Works Committee meeting. That presentation intentionally initiated the CIP discussions for FY24 a month earlier than the previous CIP planning cycles to precede City Council consideration of a No-Tax Increase Bond Issue that would potentially include numerous capital projects.
