

In an effort to promote wider dissemination and reach more residents, the FY25-29 CIP will be available for public review and comment as part of a virtual public meeting on the City's website between April 15 and May 12. The draft CIP documents will be available for review online, on the City's website. Residents can also find the CIP comment page by going to www.cityofls.net, and then type "CIP public hearing" in the search box near the top right of the home page of the City's website. Public Comments on CIP, and suggested improvements, are also considered throughout the year in Service Requests, CIP Public Meetings, Public Comments at City Council Meetings, etc.

The FY25 CIP Draft front-end summary, proposed funding summaries, and maps of the various categories from the draft FY25 CIP version will be presented to the full City Council (PWC) on April 23, 2023 in the form of a written report during Staff Roundtable. That report provides an overview of the FY25 CIP. The purpose of this summary report is to provide Council members additional information in advance of the Planning Commission meeting, with ample time to review the document, ask questions, submit comments, and prepare for the final FY25 CIP version advanced to Council preceding the budget approval after the Planning Commission resolution.
