### Parks Department Retreat / Update / Master Plans

#### 1. Summary of Master Plan Update

- Set aside land for future parks and trails prior to development or as part of the development process
- Create destination parks, accessible parks, and desired facilities and programming as part of an economic development strategy
- Create city parks as "entrance" parks into regional parks and trails
- Create unique facilities and programming in partnership with other agencies and adjacent to existing facilities
- Connecting parks to each other and activity centers with trails
- Preserve Lee's Summit's high value resources for enjoyment by future generations
- Maintain existing parks, facilities, and trails to ensure industry standards are met
- Ensure funding sources and levels are diverse, sustainable, and meet the needs of the community
